About the Lt. Amit Singh Memorial Foundation

Lt. This Sangosthi, which included activities like inauguration of Smriti Bhawan, essay/elocution competition and talent search for students of schools and higher secondary schools from different states, health camps, national conference on horticulture, national exhibition, farmers quiz, distribution



of quality seeds and planting materials of the agricultural and horticultural crops, diversity shows, litchi/mango eating competition and spiritual discourse to inculcate ethics and values.

Since then Swadesh Prem Jagariti Sangosthi and conference are an annual function. The 2nd Swadesh Prem Jagriti Sangosthi (SPJS) and conference were organised at Bangalore in 2010. Subsequently, 3rd SPJS in 2011 was organised at Dehradun. The events was a great success. 4th Swadesh Prem Jagriti Sangosthi was organised from 27-31 May, 2012 at OUAT, Bhubaneswar, and 5th SPJS was organised on May 28-31, 2013, at JISL Jalgaon, Maharashtra. 6th SPJS was organized at NAU, Navsari and 7th SPJS was organised at Chitrakoot, Satna, Madhya Pradesh. The 8th



SPJS was organized at JISL Jalgaon, Maharashtra and 9th SPJS was organized at JAU, Junagadh, Gujarat. Subsequently 10th SPJS was organized at DRPCAU, Pusa, Samastipur, Bihar, 28th to 31st May, 2018 and 11th SPJS was organized at GBPUA&T, Pantnagar, Uttarakhand. Due to Covid-19, virtual 12thSPJS-2020 was organized from Dubai and SPJS-13

was organized at PJTSAU, Rajendranagar, Hyderabad, Telangana, from 16-19 September, 2021.Now the 14th SPJS -2022 and a National conference is scheduled to be organised at CSAUA&T, Kanpur, Uttar Pradesh.

You will agree with me that during the year despite Pandemic Covid-19, the Foundation took activities with New normal of digital approaches. The Foundation organised 12th Swadesh Prem Jagriti Sangosthi in the form of webinar entitled Post Pandemic (Covi-19) challenges and options in Agriculture including horticulture on 28th May, 2020, which was well attended from across the globe by more than 1000 delegates. The conference highlighted the emerging issues, caused due to pandemic and discussed various options. The recommendations were communicated to all the stakeholder for action. The Foundation fed poor people and distributions food to large number on people 3rd September. Webinar was organised on production and utilisation of fruits. The ASM Foundation also supported webinar organised by CHAI and other organisations.

To inculcate the spirit of healthy and fair competitiveness and catalysing the minds of the people, to serve the society better, ASM Foundation has instituted many rewards and awards. The rewards include the cash prizes to the winners of national debates/elocution of National Talent search in Horticulture. Different awards instituted by the Foundation to recognise the outstanding contributions made by different personnels in their respective fields for the welfare of the society, at large include, Amit Krishi Rishi Award, Amit Padma Jagriti Award, Amit Prabudh Manishi Award, Amit Swah Award, Amit Udyan Ratna Award, Amit Agrani Award, National Talent Award in Horticulture, Best All Rounder Awards (for school students), and Lt. Amit Singh Memorial Best Performing Centre of AICRP. Amit Best student Award (JAU, Junagadh and DrYSRHU, Venkataramannagudem, West Godawari, AP.) 4.0 AWARDEES OF THE YEAR, 2022

4.1 Amit Krishi Rishi Award- 2022

4.1.1 DR. ASHOK DALWAI



Ashok Dalwai, as a member of the Indian Administrative Service, 1984 batch of the Odisha Cadre has served in different capacities at both field and policy formulation stages in the States of Odisha and Karnataka, as also in Government of India. His grass root level experience in serving in different backward and tribal pockets of Odisha, besides as District Collector of Kalahandi (Odisha) and Raichur (Karnataka); and in urban

management, as Commissioner of Bangalore City Corporation brought him close in understanding of peoples' issues in both rural & urban settings. At the senior level, he has served as Secretary and Principal Secretary in the Departments of Industries, Steel, Mines and Textiles, besides holding various tenures as Chairman and Managing Director of Public Sector Undertakings, Research & Academic Institutions including the Government Medical College. He is the Founder-Chairman of Karnataka Sugar Institute, Belgaum which has now been named after the legendary Shri S. Nijalingappa. He has been serving Government of India since 2010. He is one of the initial members of Unique Identification Authority of India (UIDAI) team that rolled out bio-metric-based resident enrolment for Aadhaar. As Head of the Technology Centre of UIDAI, his role in building a robust technology platform has been well appreciated. Since 2015, he has been with the Ministry of Agriculture & Farmers' Welfare, Government of India. He is presently serving as Chief Executive Officer, National Rainfed Area Authority in the rank of Union Secretary. He has also been appointed as the Chairman of Commodities Derivative Advisory Committee (CDAC) by the Securities Exchange Bureau of India (SEBI), Mumbai and has been serving in this capacity since the year 2019. He has always focussed on effective delivery of services and on good governance. Some of the important contributions include the Ten-Year Perspective Plan on Land & Water Management for Kalahandi District, 1992-93 to 2001-02, first Agriculture Policy of the State of Odisha, first Textile Policy of Karnataka, Self-Assessment Scheme for assessment of Property Tax in the city of Bengaluru (which was subsequently adopted across the country), launch of Swachh Bengaluru - a new initiative in solid waste management, Participatory Irrigation Management, restructuring of State PSUs etc. For Government of India, he has drafted the Model Agriculture Produce & Live Stock Marketing (Promotion & Facilitation) Act, 2017; Model Contract Farming & Services Act; and Guidelines for Gramin Rural Agriculture Markets (GrAMs) etc. In the recent years, he headed the Committee appointed by the Union Ministry of Rural Development to draft the 'New Generation Guidelines on Watershed and Spring-shed Development Projects, 2022', which have now been rolled out by Government of India for adoption across the country. He also chaired the Committee on electronic Negotiable Warehousing Receipt (eNWR) system for World Food Programme (WFP), as also for drafting the United Nations Food Security System (UNFSS), India Report 2021. He is now leading a committee on restructuring of Crop Insurance Scheme (PMFBY) for the Ministry of Agriculture. It is based on his recommendation that, the Directorate of Secondary Agriculture has been set up by Government of Karnataka, which is the first State to do so in the country. More importantly, as Chairman of the Inter-Ministerial Committee on Doubling Farmers' Income, he has submitted a fourteen-volume strategy with specific recommendations to the Government. The recommendations of the DFI Report, 2018 effect a paradigm shift in the agricultural sector by treating it as an enterprise and emphasise on income security & welfare of the farmers by adopting an ecosystem approach. He has now been tasked to oversee the implementation of the recommended strategy, in his capacity as the Chairman of the Empowered Body. Being a student of agricultural science - a post-graduate in Agricultural Economics and Ph.D. in Economics Dr Dalwai has always sustained his interest in academics and research. Has published several research papers and written general interest articles. He is a life time member of Indian Society of Agricultural Economics and Indian Society of Agricultural Marketing. He is an Honoured Fellow of the CHAI, He has lectured at several national & international fora. He has now been invited to be the Conference President for the 36th National Conference on Agricultural Marketing and deliver the key note address in November, 2022. His services have been well recognised by conferring many awards, to name the few are Best Outgoing Student, Col Dharwad, 1979, Best Sportsman of the year, National Police Academy, 1982, Identified as one of the ten most important persons in the State of Karnataka in a Times of India Survey, 2002, Distinguished Alumnus UAS, Bangalore, 2013, Honorary Doctorate of Science (D.Sc.), University of Agricultural Sciences, Dharwad, 2016, Honorary Doctorate of Literature (D. Mr. Shinde is pioneering as MD of Sahyadri Farmers Producer Co. A farm to fork integrated model, focusing productivity, quality, cost reduction, finance, post-harvest, logistics and marketing has helped to enhance efficiency at all the levels in the value chains and ultimately boosting farmer's income. The company has consolidated its position as one of the leading fresh fruits and vegetables exporter and processor, and is a leading grape exporter from India for the last 5 years, with export of 1500 container grape to Europe, Russia and Middle East. SFPCL is also one of the largest tomato processors in India, manufacturing Kissan ketchup. Looking at the need for the direct consumer linkage for the Indian farmers, SFPCL has ventured into its own retail chain for fruits, vegetables and processed products. 4.3.1 DR. K.P. SINGH (CF-285)



Born on 1st June 1968, graduated from Aligarh Muslim University in Chemistry (Biomembrane Science) and earned post-Doctoral research experience from Cranfield University, UK and NCI-NIH Frederick USA. After his Master's and Doctorate Degree, he started his career at G B Pant University of Agricultural & Technology, Pantnagar and he served there in various positions, as an academician and administrator. He has been a

professor, coordinator, Head of Division, Chairman, Director and Vice-Chancellor in various academic institutions. He served the Chaudhary Charan Singh Haryana Agricultural University, Hisar (Haryana), a very prestigious Agricultural University of India, as a Vice-Chancellor and was a Founder Vice-Chancellor of Maharana Pratap Horticultural University, Karnal. Currently, he is the Vice-Chancellor of M.J.P. Rohilkhand University, Bareilly, Uttar Pradesh.

Dr. Singh in his career spanning 24 years has provided leadership, and direction in academic areas, guiding the faculty and administration and monitoring the programme of curriculum development besides being the best teacher. He has been implementing various policies and procedures related to the academic programme and research pursuits. He has guided twenty-two PhD, thirty-five Masters, and more than 50 incubatees/entrepreneurs. He has vast experience in handling more than two dozen national and international research and policy projects, which yielded authorship of two dozen books and more than two hundred quality research publications including patents in his credits. Currently, he is still involved in guiding PhD students and startups. Contribution and performance of the centres comprising of conduct of the trials, performance, publication, impact of the technology developed, budget utilization, timely submission of AUC etc, which are the main component of criteria of the award. In the second week of January, a committee constituted by the DDG (Hort.) and Project Coordinator as Member Secretary, scrutinize the achievements/performance of the centres and submit the report to the DDG (Hort.) for approval. The name of the selected centre always keep confidential and it will be disclosed during the inaugural session of the AICRP-VC workshop and awarded to the representatives of the concerned centre by the Chief Guest of the function
