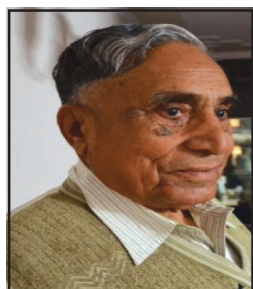

Amit Singh, at his birth place, Mahamada, Pusa, Bihar. The village Mahamada is known to have brought modern agriculture, since the Imperial Agricultural Research Institute (IARI) was established at Pusa in the year 1905, now known as Indian Agricultural Research Institute (IARI), (commonly known as Pusa Institute) in Delhi. This Sangosthi, which included the activities like inauguration of Amit Smriti Bhawan, essay/elocution competition and talent search for students of secondary and higher secondary schools from different states, health camps, national conference on horticulture, national exhibition, farmers' quiz, distribution of quality seeds and planting materials of the agricultural and horticultural crops, diversity shows, litchi/mango eating competition and spiritual discourse to inculcate ethics and values has moved forward in its journey. With the overwhelming response and encouraging feedback of participants of the first Sangosthi, the organisers were encouraged to make this event as an annual feature as the activities of the Foundation. Since then, the Foundation organized this mega event on May, 28-31, every year. The 2nd SPJS was organised in the year 2010 at Bangalore, Karnataka, 3rd SPJS in the year 2011 was held at Dehradun, Uttarakhand, 4th SPJS in the year, 2012 was organised at Bhubaneswar, Odisha, 5th SPJS was hosted at JISL, Jalgaon, Maharashtra in the year 2013, 6th SPJS was held at NAU, Navsari, Gujarat in the year 2014, 7th SPJS in the year 2015 was hosted at MGCGV, Chitrakoot, Madhya Pradesh, 8th SPJS-2016, once again, was hosted at JISL, Jalgaon, Maharashtra, 9th SPJS, in 2017 was hosted at JAU, Junagadh, 10th SPJS- 2018 was organised at DRPCA, Pusa, Bihar, 11th SPJS-2019 was organized at GBPUA&T, Pantnagar,. The year 2020 was affected by the Pandemic Corona Virus and there was lockdown, thus the conference was done in virtual mode on 28 May, 2020, In the year conference was done on 16-19 September, 2021 at PJTSAU, Hyderabad due to pandemic Covid -2019 in May. The SPGS-2022 was hosted at CSAUAT, Kanpur. The conferences have touched on topical issues. All these events had a great success in fulfilling the aim and objectives of the



Foundation. The recommendation of the conferences have been by and large, very useful for policy makers and have been adopted by various stakeholders.

To inculcate the spirit of healthy and fair competitiveness, for catalysing the minds of the people and encourage them to serve the society better, ASM Foundation has instituted many rewards and awards. The awards include the cash prizes to the winners of national debates/elocution in National Talent Search at University level. Various awards have also been instituted by the Foundation to recognise the outstanding contributions made by the stakeholders in Agriculture/Horticulture and allied sectors in their specialised sectors for the welfare of the society at large. These awards include **Amit Krishi Rishi Award, Amit Padma Jagriti Award, Amit Prabudh Manishi Award**. The recipients of awards include leading and distinguished educationists, corporate sectors, scientists, entrepreneurs, farmers, students and leading research institutes, which act as a great driving and inspirational force for the participants and stakeholders to work harder with full zeal in their respective fields to be among the recipient of such awards. Besides, Amit Agrani Award, National Talent Award in Horticulture, Best All Rounder Award (for school students), Lt. Amit Singh Memorial Best Performing Centre of AICRP on Vegetables, Lt. Amit Singh Memorial Best Performing Centre of AICRP on Palms. Junagadh Agriculture University has started Amit Gold Medal for the best students in Horticulture, from 2019, which is conferred on best student of horticulture on merit. A Amit Singh Memorial Gold medal for best student has also been instituted at DRYSRHU, Venkataratanamgudem. The Foundation has also instituted West Godavari, Andhra Pradesh, an award by endowment. It shall start from 2023 by conferring to best selected student during the convocation. The activities of the Foundation carried so far have been very successful as is evident from its impact on impressionable tender minds of youth to in-still patriotism and building nationalistic character in them, economic empowerment of the poor farmers through innovative technologies and current knowledge disseminated through conferences and exhibitions on agriculture and horticulture. The services of the Foundation were recognised by AIASA, New Delhi, 2017. It conferred award in recognition of outstanding contributions in reconstruction of rural India by involving youth in Agriculture. The Foundation has expanded its activities over these years with major focus on improving the health of children and empowerment of women. From the Desk of the Chairman...



Devotion to humanity and beneficence is patriotism, thus Lt. The activities during the year 2022 also included, distribution of seeds, school bags to school children, demonstration of new technologies to farmers and confidence building in youths. The Foundation organized a camp for distribution of food, sanitiser and mask to poor. In the honour of Lt. Amit Singh, “Shaheed Diwas” was observed on 3rd September 2022, which was followed by a Kisan Sangoshthi, organised to discuss about application of precision horticulture and a training was also organised on organic farming. Empowerment of farmers was done through sharing the knowledge by the experts. Apart from the above, the ASM Foundation office at Mahamada executed several activities for the benefit of children by providing them education, vocational support, and celebrating the Independence Day and Republic Day. 4.1 Amit Krishi Rishi Award - 2023

4.1.1 Padma Shree (Late) Dr. B.H. Jain



Dr. B.H. Jain, Founder and Chairman of JISL, Jalgaon, Maharashtra, a man of small ideas, which created big revolutions, Padma Shree Dr. B.H. Jain, who focused on Leave the Earth Better than you found it, and practiced what he preached and, built his entire business on a foundation of inclusiveness and sustainability over the last five decades. He toiled hard to bring smile on the face of over five million farmers though building confidence on technology-led development. Dr. Jain was a visionary, *karma-yogi* and devotee of excellence, who established a billion-dollar rural multinational company. A spirited champion of the small farmers, whom he saw

toiling nobly in the face of all adversity, Dr. Jain rose to head the world's second largest drip irrigation company and a pioneering work in the farming sector, unparalleled by any single individual in this country's history. Continuing his social commitment through industry and agriculture he established the Jain Group through striking success. The R&D established by him played a significant role in achieving astounding pace of the growth resulting in remarkable quality and effective distribution network providing wide range of products for capturing huge market, Dr. Jain constantly innovated with new technologies to make them affordable and within reach of the farmers.

He believed in nurturing the young with good education and sound values, primarily to be a good person. Values that have stood the test of time, but are slowly and surely being eroded by the influence of Western culture on our youth. The residential school, Anubhuti, that he established in Jalgaon, follows modern teaching methods, curriculum and offers an international quality of education, but retains many Indian customs & values which was seen in the Gurukul. He firmly believed that economic conditions should not prevent deserving children from getting a good education. This prompted him to start another school for children whose parents live below the poverty line. Today hundreds of bright youngsters, provided with free education, books, wholesome meals and all other necessities, bear witness to the faith, he reposed in them and are blooming into bright young citizens of tomorrow.

A much sought after public speaker, Dr Jain would hold his audience spellbound with his knowledge & eloquence on various subjects – be it work related, political or social. Without as much as a scrap of paper as an aide memoire, his prodigious memory could recall data, events or recount anecdotes and stories to enthrall, entertain and captivate his audiences. Speaking extempore with such erudition and passion on agriculture for nearly an hour at the Harvard Business School during his last visit to the US, prompted Prof. Ray A. Goldberg, (George M. Moffett Professor of agriculture and business, Emeritus) calling him his brother! The professor later visited Jain Irrigation, Jalgaon with a delegation that included other professors and the Dean of Harvard Business School. The HBS today uses Jain as a case

study for their graduate program. There were so many subjects that he was committed to that he has written several books on them. His book on the ills of the social structure written 20 years ago, is as relevant today as it was then. His book on his experiments and learnings with watershed management could well be used as a textbook by students and by the general public, as the subject is so pertinent and his observations so simple to understand. His unique style of management, has a thriving sustainable corporation, employing 11,000 associates, seamlessly working across five continents. This is reflected in his books – “An Entrepreneur Deciphered” & “The Enlightened Entrepreneur”.

His work & concern for the environment had its roots in the tenets of Jainism which teaches one to protect and live in tune with nature. His herculean task of transforming Jain Hills and its environs into a fertile green paradise, included planting millions of trees. Trees that were not just planted and abandoned to fend for themselves, but watered, nurtured and cared for. These efforts converted tracts of barren land into stretches of green and brought hectares of arid fallow land under cultivation. Bhau's sterling work on rain water harvesting, watershed management and conservation is a landmark in the history of agriculture in this arid region of Khandesh. His contribution to agriculture have led universities to bestow four honorary doctorates and have won him numerous national and international awards. The prestigious Crawford Reid Award for promoting proper irrigation techniques, has been given to only two Asians till date. He set up a huge Agri-Institute at Jain Hills with a faculty of agronomists and doctorates to train farmers from all over India and abroad on the latest farming methods. He established one of the finest biotech labs, doing research in various fields of agriculture. A few years ago, this resulted in one of the most socially impactful ventures-tissue culture banana, strawberry and pomegranate plant-lets. Here again farmers from across the country have seen their incomes grow exponentially because of the phenomenal yield from these plants. Such thinking had elevated him to be considered a thought leader internationally.

Dr. B. H. Jain popularly referred as Bhau, was a master of creating opportunity. His insight marched to develop many products with advance technique to fulfil the essential needs of agriculture domain for technology-led development. The first manufacturing company of micro irrigation established by him revolutionised the technology to use minimal water and get better yields. All the instruments were made available to the community through One-stop Agri Shop. With the vision and dedication, the Jain Group, under the leadership of Bhau, expanded its foot prints in 120 countries of five continents, 33 manufacturing plants having more than 11 thousand employees. For exceptionally outstanding contribution to agriculture through agriculture based industry Dr Jain, was conferred Padma Shree by the then Her Excellency the President of India in 2008. The Jain Group under the leadership of Bhau received 135 awards from the Departments, Government of India and 41 awards from the state of Maharashtra. The group also received 12 International awards. The Group has been felicitated by the semi-government and organisations of repute. While contributing valuably towards national infrastructure building the Jain Group started a model contract farming to uplift food produce and enhance the income of the farmers. He was never behind the own progress and financial gain but welfare of farmer and the community was the priority, and provided an unparalleled example of social responsibility. Bhau believed that employees are earned, developed and sustained so he could expand his industrious ambitions all around the country. He also founded the Gandhi Research Foundation, an organisation aimed to propagate the Gandhian thought, world-wide. Professional success and humanitarian concern of Bhau with focus on technology-led growth, brought the smile on millions of people, Millions of farmers around the globe could rise from rags to riches due to his efforts. Dr Jain was inspiring leader, visionary entrepreneur and motivator, who worked tirelessly with passion, empathy and compassion throughout his path-breaking, creative and meaningful life with belief of doing well by

doing good and to leave the world better than you found it. So he earned a respect of high order, from million of people through the globe as a **leader of par excellence**, who are borne in a century, to serve the mankind. Bhau completed his earthly journey on 25th February 2016, at the age of 78 years, and bid a farewell to the world with a last breath of fulfilment.

4.3. Amit Prabudh Manishi Award 2023

4.3.1 Prof. Ajeet Kumar Karnatak, Vice Chancellor, MPUAT, Udaipur



Dr. Ajeet Kumar Karnatak, Vice-Chancellor, Maharana Pratap University of Agriculture and Technology, Udaipur (Rajasthan) since October 15, 2022, was born at Almora, Uttarakhand on July 9, 1959. Before joining MPUAT, he served as Vice-Chancellor in the Veer Chandra Singh Garhwali Uttarakhand University of Horticulture & Forestry, Bharsar, Pauri-Garhwal, July 22, 2019 - October 12, 2022. Concomitantly, he also served as Vice-Chancellor, Doon University, Dehradun from December 14, 2019 to December 15, 2020. Dr. A.K. Karnatak had earned his Ph.D. Entomology from GBPUAT, Pantnagar in 1985. He has 21 years of experience academics as Professor and in a career spanning 38 years of experience in teaching, research & extension. - The applicants must have derived a majority of their income from farming at least for the past ten years.

- The farmers awarded previously for this award, need not be nominated. However, farmers who have not been selected previously but were nominated can be re-nominated.
- The nominations should be forwarded by the Head of any Research Organization of ICAR, SAUs or State Horticulture/Agriculture development authority.
- Citations will be presented to the selected 25 award winners at the valedictory function of the Sangothi.
- Three copies of nominations with passport size photographs should be submitted.
- Adherence to the guidelines is important.

19.7 Lt. Amit Singh Memorial Award for Best Coordinating Centre of AICRP

This award was instituted to create competitiveness among the centres for All India Coordinated Research Project on vegetables from across the country. The main objective of this award is to improve the working of cooperating centres for quality output by motivating scientists with the feeling of involvement and encouragement as well as to increase competitiveness among centres. Annually, this award is being conferred to the best AICRP-VC centres, selected based on the criteria formulated by a committee in consultation with DDG (Hort.), ICAR and Project Coordinator (AICRP-VC) as a Member Secretary of the said committee. Contribution and performance of the centres is mostly judged on successful conduct of the trials, performance, publication, impact of the technology developed, budget utilization, timely submission of AUC etc. The award comprise of plaque of honour and a citation during the annual workshop of AICRP-Vegetable Crops.

Rules and Regulation

Every year, in the last week of December, a proforma (Annexure) is being circulated to all the AICRP-VC centres and invite their significant contributions and performance of the last ten years in general and during the year in particular. Contribution and performance of the centres comprising of conduct of the trials, performance, publication, impact of the technology developed, budget utilization, timely submission of AUC etc, which are the main component of criteria of the award. In the second week of January, a committee constituted by the DDG (Hort.) and Project Coordinator as Member Secretary, scrutinize the achievements/performance of the centres and submit the report to the DDG (Hort.) for approval. The name of the selected centre always keep confidential and it will be disclosed during the inaugural session of the AICRP-VC workshop and awarded to the representatives of the concerned centre by the Chief Guest of the function.
