

Despite challenges like the 2020 pandemic, which led to a virtual conference, the SPJS continued to thrive, with the conferences in 2021 and 2022 hosted in Hyderabad and Kanpur respectively. 4.1.1 Shri Upender Bhai D Nathani



Shri Upender Bhai D Nathani, born on 30th June, 1979, has become the farmer by choice after, High School and ITI Mech. is cultivating on 4.8 ha. hectares of the land. Upendra Nathani is a farmer having 4.8 ha. combine land of family with drip irrigation facility. Whole farm is managed by organic & natural farming since 2008 and organic certified by Gujarat Organic Products Certification Agency (GOPCA). He has Gir cows, 6 heifers & a pair of bullocks. He grows Groundnut, turmeric, chillies, mung bean in kharif and wheat, gram coriander, cumin in rabi. He also has guava & vegetables in rabi. He uses cow urine,dung for preparation of Jivamrit, Ghanjivamrit,

vermicompost, dasparni, brahmastra, agnistra, buttermilk+ cow urine+neem for plant protection. Due to organic farming carbon conten increased 4 times and water requirement also reduced irritating at 12-15 days intervals. His innovation in value addition of turmeric powder, groundnut oil, cumin+ coriander powder, red chillies powder and salt under brand name of VRAJRAJ ORGANICS. He also sells wheat, gram etc. organic directly to consumers at premium price. He modified turmeric boiling machine by his own way which reduced time, fuel and labour. He gives this machine to other farmers also. Though area is groundnut bowl, seeing his success by other farmers adopted it. His farm is under drip irrigation. He maintains 7/8 varieties of turmeric, okara, groundnut. His cost of production is reduced 50% with profit enhanced to 50%. He has been awarded as Best Organic farmers by ATMA gov, Gujarat. District, and by Organics India, Lucknow and many. His name has proposed by Dr. A. R . Pathak, Ex VC, NAU & JAU for Amit Udyan Ratna wards-2024.

chemical called Jeeva Mutra. Mr. Kumar actively encourages other farmers to adopt this spray mixture for enhanced farming benefits, inspired by discussions with Dr. H.P. Singh, Chairman of CHAI, on new agricultural technologies. He advocates for the adoption of new technologies and crop protection measures, including the use of indigenous chemical sprays to safeguard crops from wildlife. His contributions have been recognised through an appreciation certificate from ASM Foundation for his participation in the Global Conference on precision horticulture for improved livelihood, nutrition, and environmental services, as well as for his work in the National Seminar on the importance of Medicinal and Aromatic Plants in Bihar Economy. With a deep understanding of water body irrigation capacity, he efficiently irrigates Kharif and Rabi crops over 3.5 hectares using sprinkler systems. Mr. Thakur has developed innovative techniques to protect his crops from various animals, including cows, buffaloes, goats, and wild animals, utilizing a spray mixture composed of one egg

and 5 liters of water. He has also introduced a novel spray technique named Jeeva Amrit, comprising 5 kg cow dung, 2 kg Gur, 2 kg Basan, 250 gms Bargad Mitti, 4 liters of cow urine, and 150 liters of water, benefiting farmers in the vicinity. With a lifelong connection to agriculture, Mr. Thakur has diversified into dairy farming, fisheries, and vermicompost production. His extensive experience in horticulture is complemented by regular training initiatives. He has served continuously as president in Sahkari Pax and has received numerous certificates for his participation in global and national conferences and workshops in 2023. Additionally, he was awarded a certificate by the Agriculture Department, Government of Bihar, for securing the second position in a one-day horticulture exhibition held on 13th December 2017. Mr. Thakur also underwent training from 18th August 1998 to 30th August 1999 under the Pradhan Mantri Yojna organized by the Small Industry Service Institute, Ministry of Industry, Government of India



Places of learning in the field of agriculture form the nucleus or centre of origin of all recent and advanced development in this field. This is not only the place where young goons are imparted with basic and advanced knowledge in their specialisation but are trained professionally which further impacts the scenario of national agriculture research and development. These knowledge generating rather worshiping centres have key responsibility to produce highly motivated and energetic human resources to lead the nation's agriculture at internationally competitive environment. Person in command of these centres has stupendous task not only to provide a very positive and motivated environment for healthy development but to train the young growing brains in a disciplined manner. There is imperative need to recognise the contribution of these educational leaders enormously as their devotion to the development of society is no manner less than high-level planner or entrepreneur. Therefore, a duly constituted high-level search committee in national consultation decides on uniquely distinguished educationist academicias human resource development for this award.

- High power national level search committee is constituted.
- A national level consultation is undertaken on extraordinarily accomplished personality in the field educational exemplary who has made the difference and provided the leadership in shaping educational system of agriculture and allied sector at national level.
- One unique name is recommended unanimously to the Managing Trustee for final approval.

19.5. Amit Swah Award

One of the objectives of the Foundation is secured health for the people. The foundation wishes for physical, mental and intellectual health which bring wellness to the people. Therefore, it is imperative to recognise the services of leaders who have made difference for the wellness of mankind. Amit Swah Award recognises the outstanding contribution and visionary approach for the total health of the people. Unparallel leader in the field of wellness who brought revolution, is recommended by duly constituted search committee conferred with this prestigious award on early basis during the Swadesh Prem Jagriti Sangosthi. Based on national level consultation and recommendations of the committe, Board of Trustees approves for conferment of the award.

19.6. Udyan Ratan Award

Recognizing the contributions of farmers in the development of Agriculture/ Horticulture, which have hardly been noticed, Lt. Amit Singh Memorial Foundation instituted an annual award "Udyan Ratan" for inspiring

the farmers for their innovations, adoption and dissemination of technologies. The award was constituted to recognize their outstanding contributions for exemplary farming, which is an attribute of a farmer in the area of horticulture/agriculture. Selection of farmers for Udyan Ratan from different corners of the country is a herculean task. Consequently, nominations are sought annually from SAUs, ICAR institutes, departments and from persons of repute.

India has taken big strides witnessing 8 times growth in horticultural production during the last 60 years. Besides, the technologies development by prestigious research institutes of ICAR, farmers too have played key roles in the refinement of technologies. This has lead to the adoption of technologies resulting in the overall manifold growth of horticulture. Irrespective of their contributions, they have been rarely been recognized and appreciated for their extraordinaire work.

The Foundation, in course of its movement, sincerely contemplated on this issue and made efforts to encompass progressive farmers who have deviated from the beaten track for faster growth of horticulture. In recognition of the contributions made by illustrious and innovative farmers, the ASM Foundation has instituted the "Udyan Ratan" award which is conferred on the farmers on the occasion of "*Swadesh Prem Jagriti Sangoshthi*" to provide them their deserved recognition. The award consists of a Plaque of Honour, a Citation and a Certificate.

Nomination: Person must be nominated by a responsible authority of his area like:

- Head of any agriculture/horticulture institute/university/research organization/state government department of agriculture/horticulture.
- President/Vice presidents of societies like Agriculture/Horticulture/related fields.
- Awardees of Padma Bhushan, Udyan Ratan or other reputed awards of the country.

Judging Criteria

The nominations shall be judged by the committee on the basis of contributions made by the farmer in the field of horticulture. Nominations received will be examined by committee comprising of distinguished personalities in the sector which shall be constituted by the Foundation for this purpose. Reviewed by the subsequent committee the decision of the jury shall be final. The successful farmers will be communicated well in advance and have to come and receive the award in person at the place notified by the foundation at their own cost.

General Guidelines

- Applicants must be a resident of India. Eligibility for award is limited to farmers, agricultural leaders and allies of the agricultural industry who have made outstanding contributions to horticulture and for the enhancement of the quality of rural life.
- A nominal entry fee in the form of Demand Draft in favour of Lt. Amit Singh Memorial Foundation payable at New Delhi.
- The submissions are welcome from throughout the country.
- The applicants must have derived a majority of their income from farming at least for the past ten years.
- The farmers awarded previously for this award, need not be nominated. However, farmers who have not been selected previously but were nominated cane be re-nominated.

- The nominations should be forwarded by the Head of any Research Organization of ICAR, SAUs or State Horticulture/Agriculture development authority.
- Citations will be presented to the selected 25 award winners at the valedictory function of the Sangothi.
- Three copies of nominations with passport size photographs should be submitted.
- Adherence to the guidelines is important.

19.7 Lt. Amit Singh Memorial Award for Best Coordinating Centre of AICRP

This award was instituted to create competitiveness among the centres for All India Coordinated Research Project on vegetables from across the country. The main objective of this award is to improve the working of cooperating centres for quality output by motivating scientists with the feeling of involvement and encouragement as well as to increase competitiveness among centres. Annually, this award is being conferred to the best AICRP-VC centres, selected based on the criteria formulated by a committee in consultation with DDG (Hort.), ICAR and Project Coordinator (AICRP-VC) as a Member Secretary of the said committee. Contribution and performance of the centres is mostly judged on successful conduct of the trials, performance, publication, impact of the technology developed, budget utilization, timely submission of AUC etc. The award comprise of plaque of honour and a citation during the annual workshop of AICRP-Vegetable Crops.

Rules and Regulation

Every year, in the last week of December, a proforma (Annexure) is being circulated to all the AICRP-VC centres and invite their significant contributions and performance of the last ten years in general and during the year in particular. Contribution and performance of the centres comprising of conduct of the trials, performance, publication, impact of the technology developed, budget utilization, timely submission of AUC etc, which are the main component of criteria of the award. In the second week of January, a committee constituted by the DDG (Hort.) and Project Coordinator as Member Secretary, scrutinize the achievements/performance of the centres and submit the report to the DDG (Hort.) for approval. The name of the selected centre always keep confidential and it will be disclosed during the inaugural session of the AICRP-VC workshop and awarded to the representatives of the concerned centre by the Chief Guest of the function.
